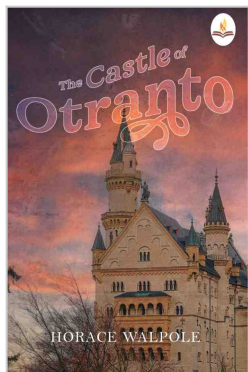

Horace Walpole was an English writer, art historian, politician, and the son of Sir Robert Walpole, who is often regarded as the first “de facto” Prime Minister of Great Britain. Walpole’s blend of Gothic architecture, medieval romanticism, and supernatural terror has made him a lasting figure in literary history, and his works, particularly *The Castle of Otranto*, (1764), which is widely regarded as the first Gothic novel.
