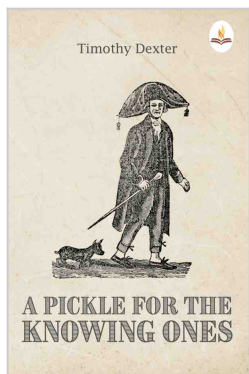

Timothy Dexter (1747–1806) was an eccentric American businessman and author best known for his bizarrely successful ventures and his chaotic book, *A Pickle for the Knowing Ones* (1802). Despite having little formal education, Dexter amassed wealth through unconventional investments, like shipping coal to Newcastle, which improbably prospered. His book was written without punctuation or standard spelling, embodying his unconventional personality. Dexter's oddities and unlikely achievements have cemented him as a unique figure in American history.
